Our clubs have expanded their signature projects, with over 500 shared through entries in the Signature Project Contest. These signature projects — from playgrounds and parks to festivals and fundraisers — showcase the hallmark of Kiwanis: the lasting impact clubs create in their communities.

Together, we have amplified our impact through our support of the Kiwanis Children's Fund, raising over US\$2.2 million. More than 100 clubs have stepped up to become Impact Clubs for The Possibility Project, each pledging to give an average of at least \$500 per member over five years — a commitment that plays a major role in improving the lives of children around the world.

We have also committed to our Service Leadership Programs through mentorship, chartering clubs and ongoing support. So far this year, we've chartered 66 K-Kids clubs, 87 Builders Clubs, 153 Key Clubs and 25 Circle K International clubs.

Key Club celebrated 100 years of impact, with 17 clubs empowering future generations by committing gifts of \$1,925 or more to the 1925 Club. Alumni committed to staying connected through over 10 events across districts. These gatherings strengthen lifelong ties to the Kiwanis family, expand professional networks and support the programs that shaped their leadership journey.

Together, we are creating lasting impact. From Impact Clubs and signature projects to new clubs and committed supporters, our efforts are shaping brighter futures for children and communities. Through Service Leadership Programs and alumni connections, we remain committed to mentorship, growth and lifelong ties to the Kiwanis family — leaving a legacy of service that will inspire generations to come.
